At the Sixth International Congress of Geography (London, 1895), G. Gerland (Germany) presented E. v. Rebeur-Paschwitz' ideas on the necessity of an international cooperation in seismology. At the Seventh Congress (Berlin, 1899) a *Commission séismologique permanente* was created. The first meeting of the Commission was held in Strasbourg in 1901 under the name of *Première Conférence Séismologique Internationale*. Subsequent conferences were held in Strasbourg (1903) and Berlin (1905). During the 2nd Strasbourg meeting, an international convention had been drafted to form the *Association Internationale de Séismologie* by signatures of member states. After being signed by 18 states the convention came in power on 1 April 1904. It consisted of a permanent *Bureau* located in Strasbourg, *General Assemblies* and a *Commission Permanente*. The *Commission Permanente* was formed during the Berlin conference and met in Rome (1906), The Hague (1907), Zermatt (1910), Manchester (1911), and Strasbourg (1922). General Assemblies were held jointly in The Hague, Manchester, and Strasbourg. The Association was dissolved by the Strasbourg General Assembly. At the first IUGG General Assembly (Rome, 1922), seismology became one of the constituent Sections of the Union. It changed its name to *International Association of Seismology* at the IV IUGG General Assembly (Stockholm, 1930) and took its present name at the IX IUGG General Assembly (Brussels, 1951).
